Working alongside mentor teachers to provide targeted reading interventions, students like Nathan Svestka witnessed significant improvement among young readers while mastering practical classroom management skills. This collaboration puts theory into practice in real-time, with UMD students making measurable impacts on elementary learners while gaining the kind of immersive experience that creates truly prepared educators. Faculty members note that students are “fully prepared to be the best educators within the state” through this real-world approach that goes far beyond textbook learning.

Associate Professor Abbie Clarke-Sather, Ph.D., has worked in both Civil and Environmental Engineering as well as the fashion and apparel industries. She and her interdisciplinary team are working to tackle textile waste with innovative machine and materials science and have created a new way to make those textiles more recyclable offering a scalable solution to a worldwide problem.
